



Santo and Santa Catarina.


#### THE OUTBREAKS DID NOT OCCUR WITHIN THE BRAZILIAN INDUSTRIAL SYSTEM, WHICH FOLLOWS THE STRICTEST BIOSECURITY PROTOCOLS

The Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock of Brazil (MAPA) is acting in the communication and adoption of measures to monitor and control the disease To date more than 40,000 laboratory tests for avian influenza have been carried out, and testing will continue

#### Prezados Senhores,

Como é de conhecimento público, há uma crise sanitária impactando diversos polos de produção avicola no mundo, com o registro de casos de influenza Aviária em aves silvestres e em unidades produtoras.

Mais de 50 países nos cinco continentes informaram focos desde novembro. Sistemas produtivos intelinos foram impactados com o abate de milhões de cabeças de aves (tirango de corte, postura, peru, etc). Mercados restingiram importações. Mesmo a oferta interna de produtos neates países foi impactada. Bilhões em prejuizo á foram registrados.









